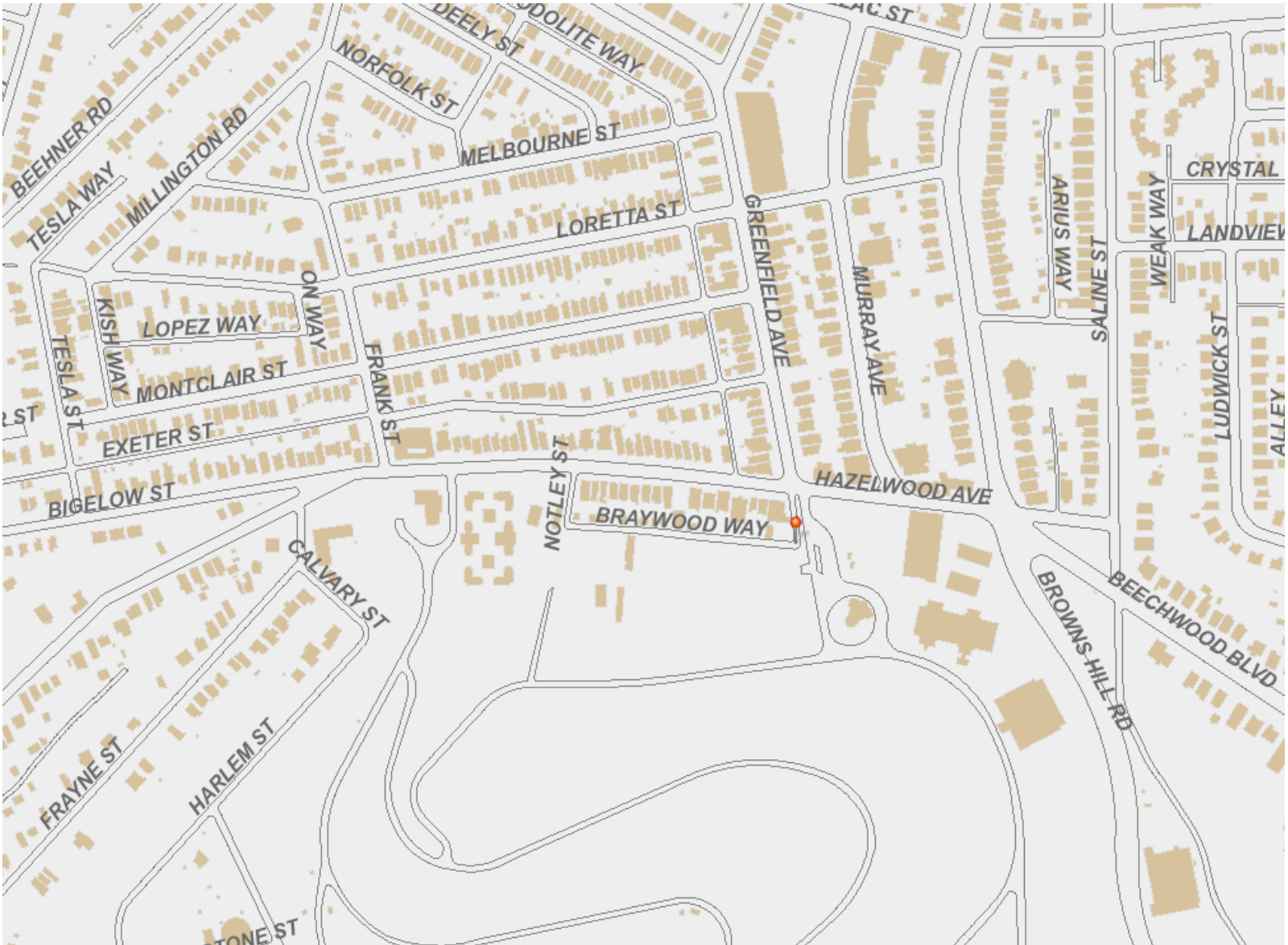

Project Overview

Project Goals

- Reduce overland flooding within the project area including roadway flooding on Braywood Way and Bray Street and flooding at the back of properties along Hazelwood Ave
- Achieve downstream flood reduction benefits and reduce peak flows via stormwater best management practices (BMPs)
- Design the proposed infrastructure with long-term maintenance considerations at the forefront
- Manage runoff from the project drainage area (about 4 acres, most of which are impervious surfaces)



Existing Conditions

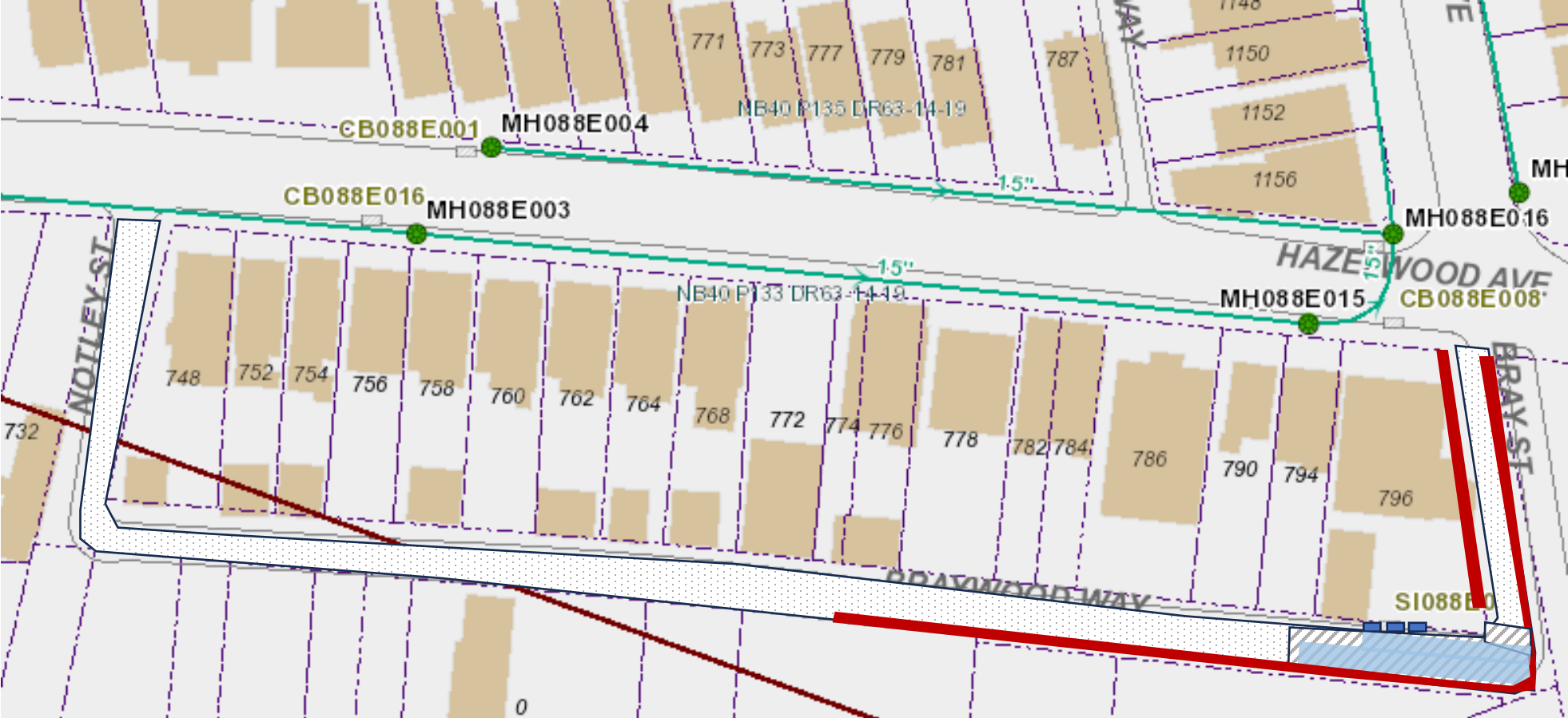

Project Overview

- Underground stormwater storage system
 - About 100 ft long, 15 ft wide, and 7.5 ft deep
 - Constructed within the Braywood Way right-of-way
- Roadway drainage improvements via new pavement and curbing throughout Braywood Way
- Continued monitoring and maintenance via PWSA

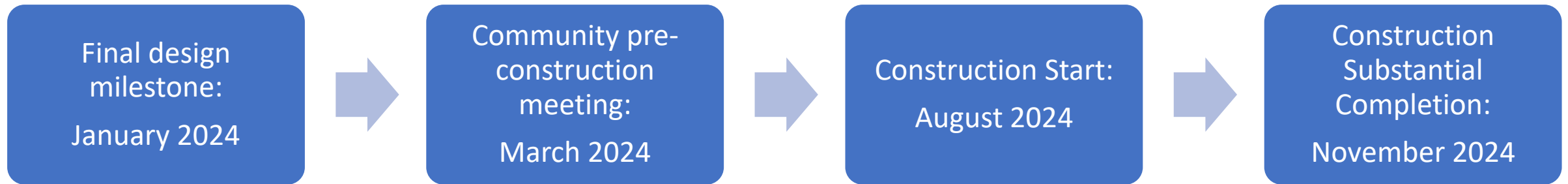
Overall Project Area
